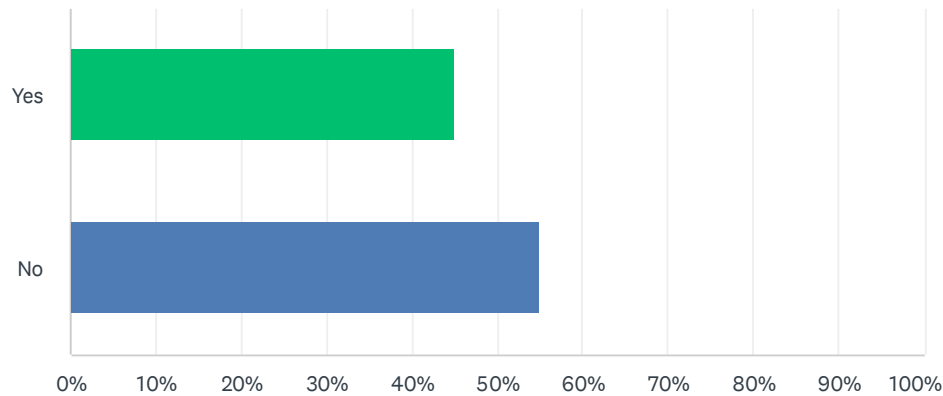


Q1 Are you in favor of the formal dissolution of the Leman Academy PTO?

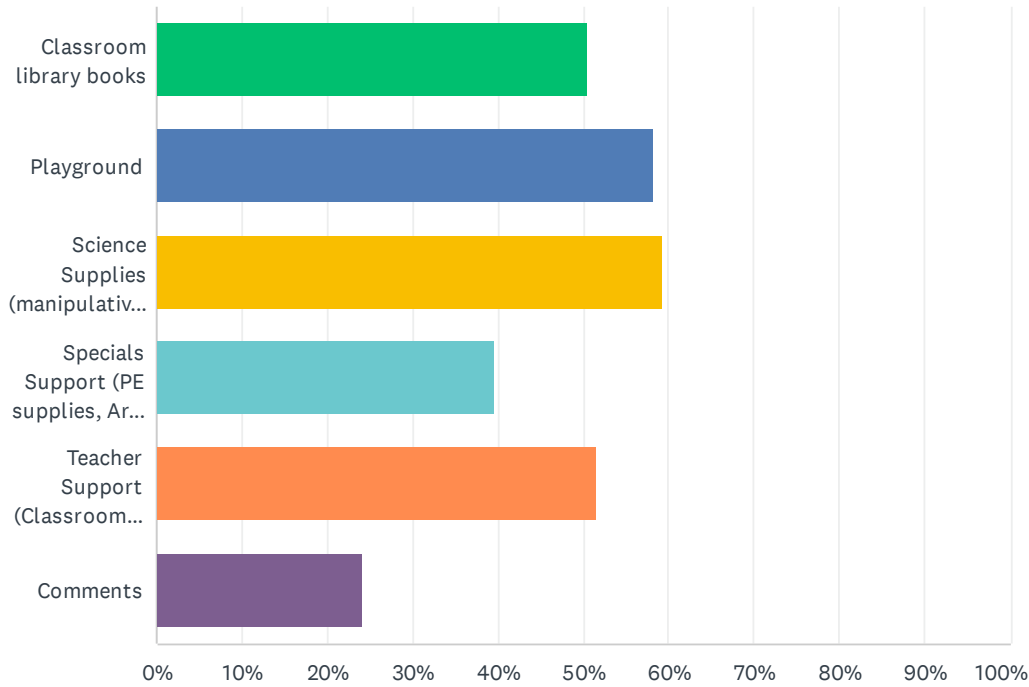

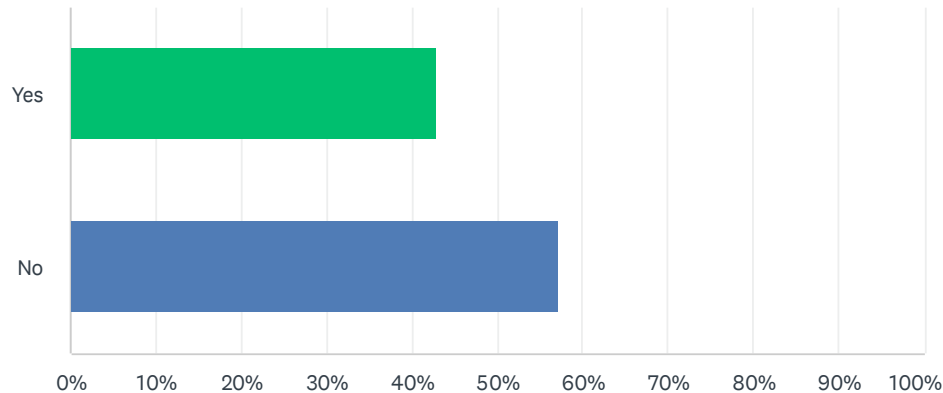

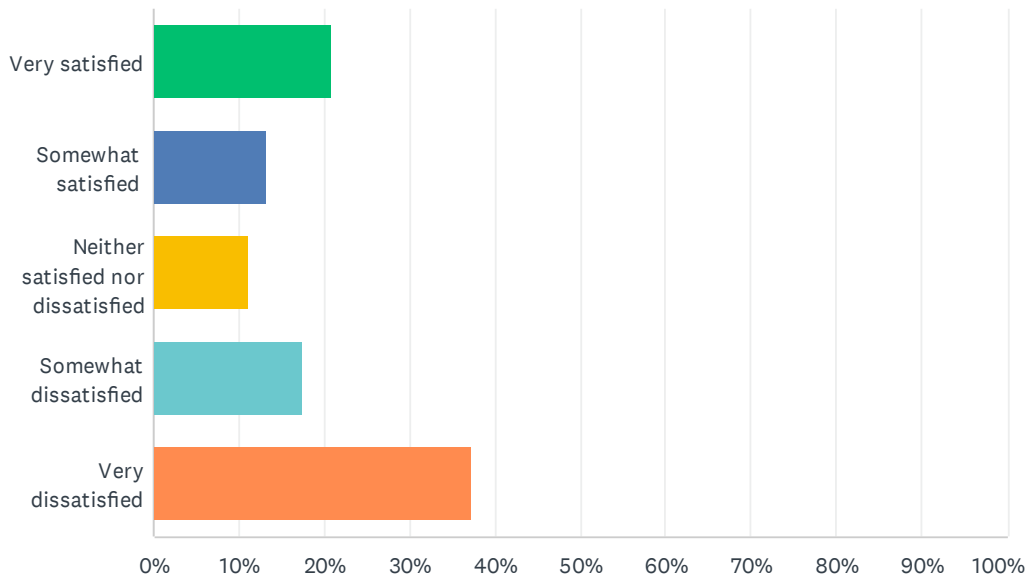
